VISITING FACULTY POSITIONS

Schwarzman Scholars Program at Tsinghua University in Beijing seeks to recruit Visiting Faculty from the world's leading universities and institutions for the 2017-18 academic year. These international scholars and practitioners will engage a highly motivated cohort of future leaders through Schwarzman Scholars' unique, interdisciplinary curriculum focused on contemporary global issues. Visiting Faculty also have opportunities to pursue independent research and develop collaborations with Tsinghua colleagues. Eligible candidates include early, mid-career and senior level academics who are available to spend from one to eleven months in Beijing.



IDEAL FACULTY PROFILE

- Expert scholar or practitioner in contemporary global issues, including (but not limited to) international relations, business, public policy, health, social sciences, technology, and the humanities
- Recognized for outstanding teaching, mentoring and/or research.
- Able to engage a diverse, international student body and interdisciplinary faculty.
- Fluent in English.

VISITING FACULTY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach or co-teach one course per semester. Courses are taught in 4-8-week modules and meet twice a week. Minimum period in residence is 4 weeks.
- Offer mentoring and guidance to Schwarzman Scholars, including thesis project advising.
- Engage the Tsinghua University community through participation in seminars, conferences and lecture series.

VISITING FACULTY BENEFITS

- Accommodation in a private faculty apartment and full meal plan at Schwarzman College.
- Round-trip business class travel to/from Beijing.
- Generous living stipend and research support.
- Special assistance for visiting faculty traveling with a partner and/or children.

MISSION

Schwarzman Scholars is preparing the next generation of global leaders to meet the challenges of the 21st Century. By educating future leaders and building a robust network of personal relationships, Schwarzman Scholars fosters mutual understanding and reduces the potential for global conflict.

LOCATION

Centrally located on the campus of Tsinghua University in Beijing, Schwarzman College is a state of the art 250,000-sq.-ft. residential and learning facility. It is among the first academic buildings in China to achieve LEED Gold and China Green certification.

PROGRAM

Schwarzman Scholars is a fully funded, one-year master's degree program at Tsinghua University — one of China's most prestigious universities. The academic program consists of a core curriculum and seminar-based electives. Scholars also gain a deep understanding of China through cultural immersion, language training, and internships with public, private and nonprofit organizations.

COMMUNITY

The inaugural class of Schwarzman Scholars is comprised of 110 students from 31 countries, selected on the basis of academic performance and leadership potential. Visiting faculty and a distinguished Academic Advisory Council include internationally recognized scholars and practitioners.
